## CARPENTERS *WORKSHOP*

With a new Paris gallery set to open this Fall, and the re-opening of their Chelsea gallery space in London, Carpenters Workshop has lots of space to promote emerging design talent, as well as its existing roster of contemporary design stars. While the gallery will show nine new works commissioned specifically for DM/B, including work by two new artists to the gallery—Studio Molen and Johanna Grawunder—it's the work of Random International that seems to be stealing the stage. "The Victoria and Albert Museum commissioned a light sculpture installation, *Swarm*, based on an exclusive body of work created for Carpenters Workshop," says new gallery director, Stephanie Gabriele. "They also just inaugurated a commissioned piece for the Wellcome Trust in London that stretches across the façade of the building and uses lights to interact with passersby that represents an algorithm seen in animal behaviors."
